#### McNair Outreach Mailing


- > McNair Scholars Program: A United States
  Department of Education initiative with a goal of
  increasing "attainment of PhD degrees by students
  from underrepresented segments of society," including
  first-generation low-income individuals and members
  from racial and ethnic groups historically
  underrepresented in graduate programs
- > Office of Graduate Studies has access to McNair Scholar's database
- > Email sent to 1250 students, and 446 potential students opened the email.
- > The email was viewed 724 times, which means they looked at it more than once MISSOURI

#### **Technical Editing**

- > 40 technical editing requests so far in FS16
- > 864 pages edited
- > Technical Editor available for one-on-one writing sessions every day from 2:00 to 4:00
- > Technical Editor is also available to visit individual departments upon request (contact Emily Seals at sealse@mst.edu)

#### **Technical Editing Survey Response**

- > 100% of survey respondents said they were somewhat or extremely satisfied with the quality of their edits
- > 100% of survey respondents would recommend the services to other graduate students
- > 95% were satisfied with the time it took to receive their edited documents
- > 95% said they would use the graduate editing services again

- > 82 theses/dissertations have been format checked for FS2016
